1 Getting started

- You need a campus-wide login (CWL).
- Go to <https://webwork.elearning.ubc.ca/webwork2/>. You will see a long list of courses with a login button next to each one. Scroll down to MATH200-ALL_2013W1 and click on the login button next to it. Use your CWL to log in.
- Once you log in, you'll see the list of problem sets currently open, and you can start working on them.

Please note that every webwork assignment closes at 11:59pm on the due date (which will generally be Sunday night), and individual extensions are absolutely not possible. The first one (Homework 1) is due on **Sunday September 15**. The correct answers appear the following morning.

2 General guidelines

Once you click on the problem set, you will see the list of problems from this assignment. To see a problem and try it, click on its number. You can try the problems in any order.

Read each problem carefully, and work out the solution on a piece of paper. When you are ready, type in your answer. You can try each problem as many times as you like.

To the right of the problem set you will see hints on how to type in the answers. Use the "preview answers" button to check if you have typed in

what you meant to type in for each answer. Note that all questions are created individually for you, so guessing or copying friends' answers is not likely to help.

3 Getting a paper copy

Once you click on a problem set, above the list of problems, there is a link "Download a hard copy of this homework set". This allows you to download and print a PDF file with your homework set, so that you can print it and think about the problems away from the computer or internet connection.

For getting help with the mathematics, it is best to visit your professor's office hours (or e-mail the professor if your professor allows it).

If you try a problem many times, and are convinced that your answer is right and typed in correctly, but the system still marks it wrong, you can try "e-mail instructor" button – this will send all the information about your problem to the TA. Please do not abuse this feature.
