

the due date, and given your reasons for the missed work. Assuming the reasons are legitimate, I will either grant an extension of a couple of days or note that you will be missing the assignment. In such circumstances your grade is computed out of a smaller number than 100 and then scaled appropriately to get a grade out of 100. For example, if an assignment counts 6% and a student informs me in advance of legitimate reasons for missing the assignment, the student would have a grade computed out of 94 and then this would be scaled to a grade out of 100 by multiplying by $100/94$. Without advance notice (to me by email or phone message to Math Office etc) the default will be a grade of 0 in the missed work but you may contact me. A student must finish a significant amount of term work in order to pass. Three missed assignments will probably be the limit.
