Course description. Math 423 is a course about commutative algebra. We cover the basics of commutative rings, ideals, modules. We generally follow the textbook. Additional topics include some algebraic geometry and combinatorial algebra.

Homework. We will have a homework roughly every two weeks. Homeworks are posted on Canvas and you have to upload your solutions also to Canvas.

Exams. We will have one midterm exams, on Tuesdays, March 5, during regular class hours. The final will be a $2\frac{1}{2}$ -hour exam scheduled by the university.

Final Grade. Your final grade will be based on your performance on homework (30%), midterm (25%) and final exam (45%).
