Clicker Question 3

What about here? ... what about here?

Suppose the power series $\sum_{n=0}^{\infty} A_n(x-3)^n$ converges when $x = -2$ and diverges when $x = -5$. Of the values $x = -6, x = -4, x = 1, x = 4, x = 7, x = 9, x = 12$, where can we be **sure that the series converges**?

- A. at $x = 1, x = 4$, and $x = 7$
- B. at $x = -4, x = 1$, and $x = 4$
- C. at $x = -4, x = 1, x = 4$,
 $x = 7$, and $x = 9$ (maybe)
- D. only at $x = 1$
- E. none of the above

Close enough to 3

The series converges at $x = -2$, so the radius of convergence is at least $|(-2) - 3| = 5$. The series diverges at $x = -5$, so the radius of convergence is at most $|(-5) - 3| = 8$
