(2) Find the interval of convergence and radius of convergence of the power series

(a) $\sum_{n=1}^{\infty} (-1)^{n-1} \frac{(x-1)^n}{n}$

(b) $\sum_{n=0}^{\infty} n!x^n$

(c) $\sum_{n=0}^{\infty} \frac{x^n}{n!}$

(d) (Final, 2014, variant) $\sum_{n=0}^{\infty} \frac{(x-2)^n}{3^n(n^2+1)}$

(e) (Final, 2011) $\sum_{n=0}^{\infty} \frac{(x-2)^n}{\log(n+2)}$
